This is such a special time for you and your family-- the addition of a new, sweet baby. I want to help you savor those memories of your sweet, little one.

When to Schedule: Newborn sessions are best in the first 10 days of your baby's birth.

During this time, your baby still sleeps a lot and his or her complexion is clear. When you call to schedule your appointment, your session will be re-served for an approximate time frame.

Notify me as soon as possible when your baby is born to set a firm date.

Before the Session:

Relax!! We both have children, so we are very familiar with the stress, fatigue, and emotions those first days home with baby may bring. What to Expect at Your Baby's Session:

We prefer to use natural light for newborn photos.

If needed, we will use studio lighting.

Baby's session can include any combination of the following:

Baby only, siblings and baby, parents and baby, family and baby.

Baby calls the shots! Babies are little people, individuals with their own likes, dislikes and personality. If baby wants to eat, we'll take a break. If baby wants to swaddle, we'll swaddle him/her.

I'll work with you and your baby to have a successful session.

Book your shoot around your baby's feeding and nap times, work with the natural rhythm of your baby.

· Nothing is the best wardrobe for a newborn –

no outfit fits a newborn. Accessories are good, little hats, crowns, dainty flower headbands, boys in crocheted hats, etc.

Bring sentimental items like the quilt that Grandma made for the baby,

a baby blanket from your own childhood – they're great for the youngster to lay on.

* Trim those tiny fingernails and toenails with appropriate baby trimmers. · Bring bloomers or decorative nappy covers if you have them.

* Use a wash cloth to clean away flaky skin and eye boogers.

Bring towels and bibs to clean up if necessary.

* If your baby takes a pacifier, bring it – if they're bottle fed, bring an extra bottle to help put the baby to sleep.

I try to schedule my newborn sessions for 10 days old or newer.

This is generally when baby is most sleepy and easiest to work with.

Babies are generally happiest when full and warm.

Try to keep baby minimally dressed but warm and wrapped in a blanket of course. Just a nappy, very loosely fastened would be perfect.

Clothes, socks and diapers can leave lines in their skin that would have to be edited out later.

Be prepared for ACCIDENTS! They happen and usually when you least expect them. Please don't let this embarrass you.

I have been pee'd on, pooped on and spit up on before. Your baby is not the first and won't be the last to get me. It comes with the job,

lol! You may want to have a change of clothes for yourself handy as well as some baby-wipes and bath towels for quick clean ups. Some extra receiving blankets will also come in handy for wrapping baby between sets.

If there are any special items such as: a teddy bear, bracelet, christening gown, hat, headband, hair bows, or a blanket maybe Great Grandma or Grandma made, or even a uniform jacket or helmet, (firefighters, military, etc.)

that you would like in some photos please have it/them handy.

I also have many props I will bring as well. Wedding rings make a great prop on baby's tiny toes if you wish to have them clean and handy.

Make sure your nails are manicured or at least clean cut since your hands will again be in many of these photos. I also ask that you not wear any necklaces, watches or long earrings since they may distract from the photos with baby.

Rest assured that I am a mum myself and have photographed many,

many babies and I always take the utmost care with your baby's safety and comfort always in mind. Safety is always the #1 priority –
